Management

IWRM (Integrated Water Resources Management) has been at the core of IOWater activities for 20 years. The French experience developed about <u>Water Agencies</u> and Basin Committees, was initially used as a basis for disseminating this know-how. The <u>European Water Framework Directive</u> (WFD - 2000) confirmed the relevance of this approach, the principles of which are applied far beyond European borders.

Implementation of IWRM requires defining: a <u>suitable institutional and legal arrangement</u> (regulation, administrative organization, and partnership agreements), management and action plans are developed with a participatory approach, specific financing, control / monitoring of the environments, harmonized information systems and sharing of information and data management, ...

IOWater and its experts are involved on <u>different geographical scales</u> (national and international river basins, sub-basins, basin-islands, ...) to propose solutions adapted to the most diverse institutional contexts, on all continents, especially in transboundary areas.

IOWater is also taking care of the Permanent Technical Secretariat of <u>INBO</u> (International Network of Basin Organizations), which was established in 1994 to promote IWRM in river basins through exchange of experience among its members. INBO currently has <u>188 member organizations</u> from 68 countries.
