News reports regularly remind us that the freshwater resources hidden below the earth's surface (groundwater resources) are under threat, and that action is urgently needed for their preservation and sustainable management.

The establishment of plans for the sustainable management and governance of these precious water resources requires investments in science, capacity-building and – above all – in raising awareness about what is at stake.

The UNESCO International Groundwater Resources Assessment Centre (IGRAC) has joined the UNESCO Water Family with the mission to build information systems that give free access to the existing knowledge on groundwater resources, to support capacity building in the management of these resources, to raise awareness, and to assist Member States.
