Dates and Venue Overview


The 8th International Water Trade Fair and Congress "Water: Ecology and Technology" ECWATECH-2008 will take place on 3-6 June 2008 in Moscow in three halls of pavilion # 2 of International Exhibition Center "Crocus Expo".

"Crocus Expo" was designed and constructed using modern building materials in accordance with the highest international architectural standards. Its core business is holding of large international exhibitions of different profiles with participation of Russian and foreign companies.

At present "Crocus Expo" is one of the largest and most perspective exhibition grounds in Russia. The indoor exhibition area of its two pavilions occupies 86 800 sg.m. and the outdoor area occupies 66 500 sg.m.

There are eleven exhibition halls in its two pavilions, equipped according to the latest international standards. conference halls with all the necessary facilities for holding exhibition and congress events, presentations and seminars, and nine negotiation rooms.

For visitors' convenience there is made a covered passageway between the first and the second pavilions of the exhibition center equipped with travellators ("speedwalks') that saves time of observing the expositions displayed on the whole showground site.



Multimedia data terminals, which help visitors to orient both in the exhibition pavilions and within each particular exhibition, are installed at the entrances to each exhibition hall and at food courts.

Advanced security systems will provide comfortable working climate for exhibitors during an exhibition period as well as during mounting and dismantling periods. Overall guarding is provided during all exhibitions in general, but at the same time exhibitors can order individual guarding of their exhibition booth.

Nowadays ECWATECH is the biggest water forum in Eastern Europe, which includes the whole spectrum of equipment and services for water resources conservation and protection, municipal and industrial water supply, sewage treatment, bottling, etc. ECWATECH is a comprehensive event, which primary constituents are exhibition and alongside congress, enabling to combine effectively advanced technologies show and discussion of issues that involves key leaders of the sector.



Continuous Growth

In 2004 when exhibition area of ECWATECH exceeded by 40% the level of 2002 many visitors considered that such sectorial trade fair focused on limited industry branches has become so big that further growth was difficult to imagine: not so many market




players as in Europe, not structured legal framework, etc. For 2006 evolutionary development of ECWATECH was expected. Reality has ruined these predictions and ECWATECH-2006 exhibition area exceeded by 48% the results of 2004.

Of course, it is hard to suppose that such a big event will continue to grow by half every two years, but organisers have all the reasons to admit that the stable growing trend will remain. First of all this supposition is based on the fact that many ECWATECH participants have started booking space for ECWATECH-2008 right after the exhibition of 2006 ended. That is the best assessment of exhibition effectiveness

At ECWATECH-2008 there will be a substantial growth of both individual stands of companies in the exhibition as well as number and the space of national and regional pavilions. It is planned to organise joint stands of Austria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, the Netherlands, Poland, Turkey. The strongest trade association of the water technology in Germany, the VDMA in Frankfurt, has applied towards the German Ministry of Economy for official governmental support for ECWATECH-

2008. So we expect the first time in the history of ECWATECH an official national pavilion from the Federal Republic of Germany. A big joint stand of Water Environment Federation -WEF (USA) is also planned for the exhibition.

Many regions of Russia plan to organise their stands as well. Association "Water-Medicine-Ecology" and Russian Association for Water supply and Water Disposal, a number of other associations



and unions are also considering their stands at the exhibition.

Registration
